Dr. Marina Oborotova will take you on a virtual tour of the Tretyakov Gallery - the best collection of Russian art in the world. She will present history of the collection, speak about the founder – Pavel Tretyakov, introduce you to the most prominent Russian painters and show the masterpieces of the gallery.

Dr. Marina Oborotova is President of the Center for International Studies, sponsoring organization for the Albuquerque International Association. She has a M.A. from Moscow State University for Foreign Affairs of the Russian Foreign Office and a Ph.D. from the Institute of World Economy and International Relations, Russia’s leading think-tank, where worked as a senior researcher. Her career includes experience in in Russia, the US, Latin America and Asia in foreign policy, international business, academic research, and university level teaching. She has written two books and over 40 articles on foreign relations and has presented numerous papers at international conferences. In the U.S. she has taught at the University of New Mexico (the Departments of History, Political Science, Anderson School of Management and Honors Program), and worked as Director of International Programs at Technology Commercialization, and as a program manager for the United States Industry Coalition. In her spare time Marina paints in pastels. Her paintings have been accepted into PSNM National Shows and Master Works of NM. In 2011 her pastel “Fourth of July” has received second place at the State Fair.
